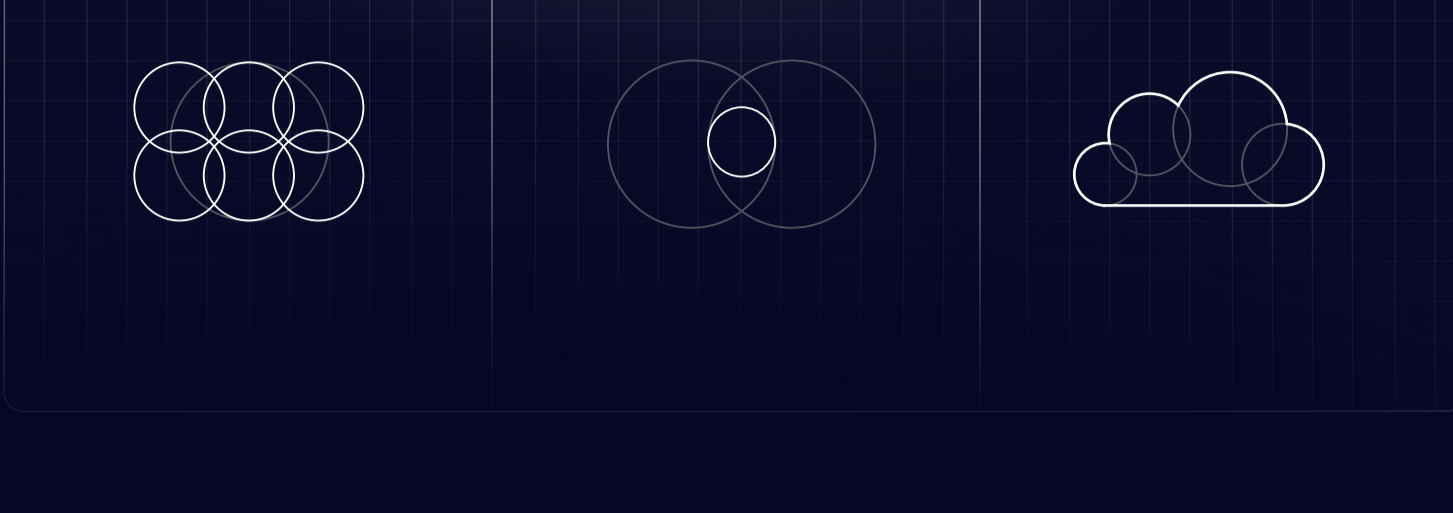

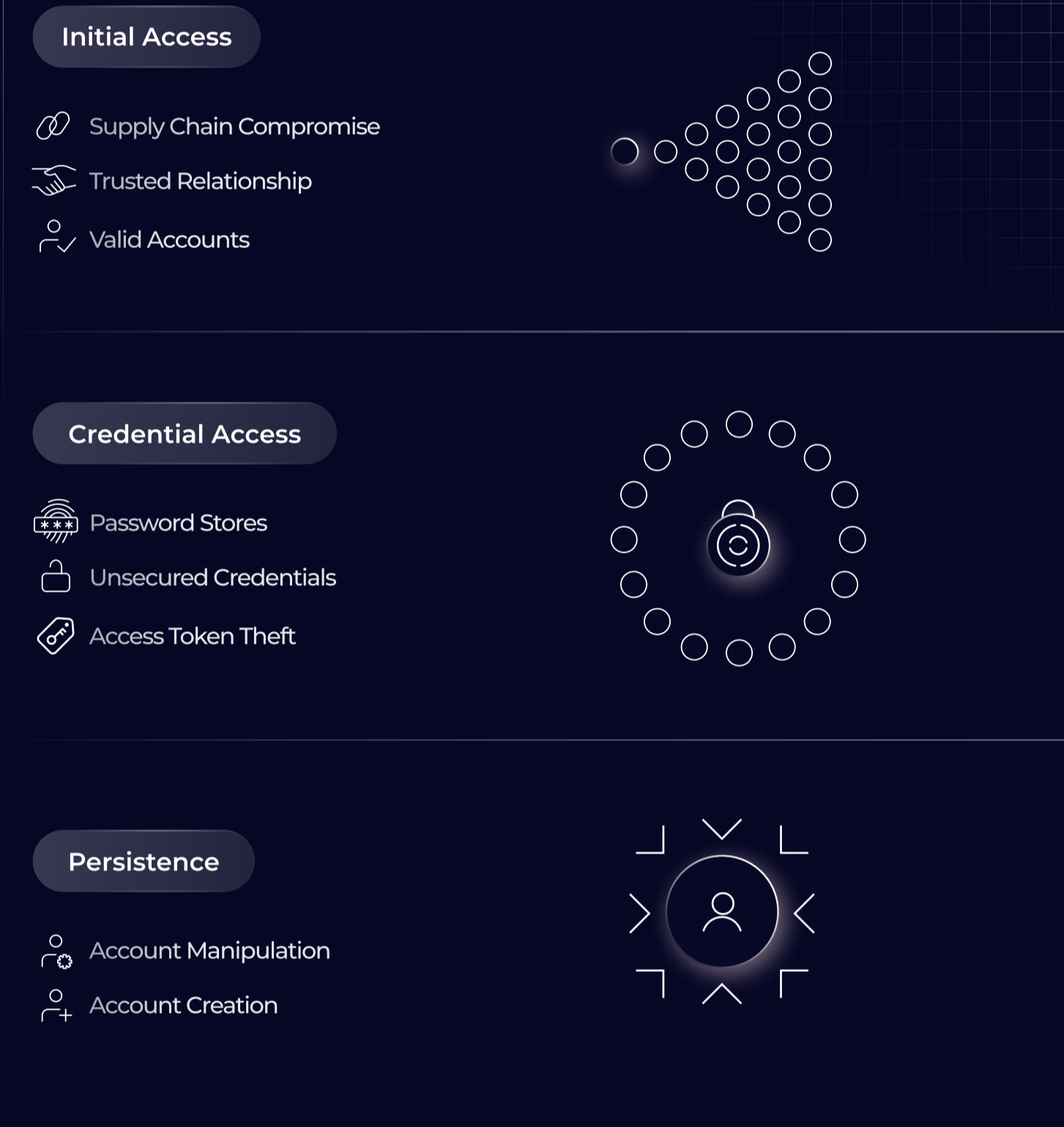
## Why NHIMs Are Needed



Breaches	Decentralized Explosion	Human-Centric Tools
<p><b>\$4.48M</b> Average cost of data breach</p> <p><b>46%</b> of organizations have had an NHI breach</p>	<p><b>1 in 5</b> NHIs are not sufficiently secured</p> <p><b>20%</b> Increase in NHI under-management in next year</p>	<p><b>69%</b> of organizations do not have the tools to prevent NHI attacks</p> <p><b>80%</b> of organizations lack processes to offboard and revoke API keys</p>

## How NHIs Are Used in Attacks

According to MITRE ATT&CK Matrix For Enterprise



### Attackers Access NHIs Through Threat Vectors

Based on Oasis data and research, in a company with 10K employees, Oasis finds:

- 253** Stale privileged unrotated NHIs (Toxic Combination)
  - Audit & Compliance
- 30** Unrotated secrets exposed to offboarded employees (Toxic Combination)
  - Insider Threat
- 207** Unverified third party vendors
  - Data Exfiltration
- 18** Active secrets with 50+ year expiration date (Toxic Combination)
  - Data Exposure
- 24** Critical service outages due to expired credentials
  - Overprivileged
